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GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR INTER-DISTRICT ATTENDANCE TRANSFER REQUEST

The Superintendent or designee may approve inter-district agreements for the following (84 Ops.Cal.Atty.Gen. 198 (2001)) reasons:

To meet the child care needs of the student for as long as they continue to use a child care provider within district boundaries.
 To meet a child's special mental or physical health needs, as certified by a physician, school psychologist or other appropriate school personnel.

(cf. 6159 - Individualized Education Program)

3. When the student has brother(s) or sister(s)attending school in a receiving district, to avoid splitting the family's attendance.

4. To complete a school year when parents/guardians have moved out of the district during that year.

5. To allow students to remain with a class graduating that year from an elementary or middle school.

6. When the parent/guardian provides written evidence (e.g. copy of a lease; completed escrow papers) that the family will be moving to the receiving district in the immediate future and would like the student to start the year in that district.

7. When there is valid interest in a particular educational program not offered in the district of residency

8. To provide a change in school environment for reasons of personal and/or social adjustment.

9. When the student is a child of an employee of the district.

Every inter-district attendance permit shall stipulate the terms and conditions under which the permit may be revoked. (Education Code 46600)

Inter-district transfers may occur when class enrollments in the district will permit the addition of nonresident students. Continuing inter-district transfer students must reapply on a yearly basis during the open enrollment period to attend the following year. Notification of placement will be made prior to the end of each school year.

Inter-districts Based on Child Care Needs

Inter-district transfers for continuing students shall be approved on an annual basis subject as long as the student continues to receive child care in the district. A student's inter-district agreement may be denied or revoked because of excessive truancy, continual disruption of the educational program, or failure to progress towards meeting district standards.

Transportation

Transportation shall not be provided for students attending on an inter-district agreement. Denial of Inter-district Transfer Agreement

The Superintendent may deny initial requests for inter-district attendance agreements for capacity considerations of a program, class, grade level, school building or adverse financial impact.

Within 30 days of a request for an inter-district permit, the Superintendent or designee shall provide parent/guardians of a student who is denied inter-district attendance regarding the process for appeal to the County Board of Education. (Education Code $\frac{46601}{10}$)

Students who are under consideration for expulsion or who have been expelled may not appeal inter-district attendance denials or decisions while expulsion proceedings are pending, or during the term of the expulsion. (Education Code $\frac{46601}{10}$)

A student's inter-district agreement may be denied or revoked because of excessive truancy, continual disruption of the educational program, or failure to progress towards meeting district standards.
