She shared data showing encouraging areas of growth in student achievement in Language Arts and Math, particularly for student subgroups, and requested feedback from the group. Link to slides. ● Annual School Experience Survey Participation Dr. Viramontez asked members to support efforts to raise parent participation in this final week. She noted that many of the listed actions in the LCAP goals are a result of survey feedback. ● Update on Continuous Improvement at all levels Dr. Viramontez presented an overview of feedback received from recent student focus group activities relating to an area that students rated low on last year’s survey: school cleanliness.
