Continuous Improvement: Dr. Viramontez shared slides as she presented information about the district’s continuous improvement process: what it is, why we are doing it, where we are in the process, and how we implement and monitor our efforts. All slides from the meeting are here.</p> <p>b. AIM program: Innovation Coordinator Julie Goo shared slides and information about the district’s Arts, Innovation and Music (AIM) program. It included the number of instructional minutes it provided to students, how the program is growing and evolving, and accomplishments from the past school year. Equity: With slides and information, Associate Superintendent Whitney Holton described the district’s anti-bias/anti-racism initiative and feedback from students and staff about their experiences at school. She explained the district’s commitment to equity and how we are addressing practices and policies that do not foster equity and inclusion for students and staff. School Share Outs</p> <p>Each representative referenced the various fundraisers, events, and community building activities at their schools since the April meeting. Several mentioned performances, multicultural fairs, and parent education offerings.</p> <p>Requests from members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● There is a need for more volunteers for yard duty and school activities. How can we remove obstacles, like the TB test process? (Discussion followed about the possibility of hosting a volunteer “intake event” where forms, TB tests, and other relevant information can be initiated.) ● A member asked for ideas to make the school’s walk-a-thon more

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engaging for students. Several members offered ideas. The S-PAC group on ParentSquare is another way for members to share ideas and resources.
